What to Bring for Rafting

Required Items:

- Swimsuit or shorts (to wear under wetsuit)
- Dry clothing for after the trip
- ID for check-in
- Credit card details from one person in the booking

Recommended Items:

- Sunscreen
- Straps for glasses (also available for purchase at the resort)
- Personal water bottle and/or tumbler (keep your beverages hot/cold & help reduce our paper cup waste)
- Cash/credit/debit card for retail purchases/rentals

Optional Items:

- Dri-FIT or thermal layers for under the wetsuit (synthetic, NO cotton)
- Wool socks
- Neoprene gloves

Included in your package:

- Full body O'Neill wetsuit & booties
- Life jacket & helmet
- Optional splash jacket for extra warmth
- Lunch & Beverages (water, coffee, tea, juice)
- Hot Tub
- Towel

What to Bring for Yoga

Required Items:

- ID for check-in
- Credit card details from one person in the booking

Recommended Items:

- Athletic wear for yoga sessions
- Personal water bottle and/or tumbler (keep your beverages hot/cold & help reduce our paper cup waste)
- Warm clothing for early morning classes

Optional Items:

- Personal yoga equipment (mat, blocks, straps, bolsters, blankets, pillows)

Included in your package:

- Yoga equipment (mat, blocks, straps, bolsters, blankets, pillows)
- Qualified yoga instructors
- 4 classes daily

What to Bring for Glamping

Required Items:

- ID for check-in
- Credit card details from one person in the booking

Recommended Items:

- Swimsuit or shorts (to wear at the beach or in the hot tub)
- Summer clothes for hot days
- Warm clothes for evenings ex. pants and a sweater (temperature cools off at night)
- Rain jacket (depending on weather)
- Hiking shoes or runners
- Hat(s)
- Sunscreen and sunglasses
- Bug spray
- Flashlight or head torch (1 lantern will be supplied per tent)
- Personal hygiene products (ex. shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, make-up, ect.)
- Personal water bottle and/or tumbler (keep your beverages hot/cold & help reduce our paper cup waste)
- Personal snacks and alcoholic beverages
 - REO does not sell alcohol on the premises, meaning, you can bring your own beverages and drink them throughout the resort. The nearest liquor stores are in Boston Bar, about 25 minutes from REO. Some soft drinks and snacks are available for purchase at REO.
- Cash/credit/debit card for retail purchases/rentals

Optional Items:

- Pillow/linens for personal reasons (ex. memory foam pillow for preexisting neck pain)

Included in your package:

- Adventure activities described in your package
- Glamping tent with full linens, extra blankets, and towels (unless you requested no linens)
- Meals including dessert & beverages (water, coffee, tea, juice)
- All resort amenities such as bathrooms, hot showers, private beach, hot tub, beach volleyball court, nightly campfires, and self-guided nature trail
- Some board games, cards, and kids toys available
- Free WIFI

What to Bring for Camping in your own tent

Required Items:

- ID for check-in
- Credit card details from one person in the booking
- Tent and camping gear
- Sleeping bag, any linens, pillows, and towels

- Adventure activities described in your package
- Meals including dessert & beverages (water, coffee, tea, juice)
